Family, friends, fellow activists and Gardena City officials and civic groups joined together to celebrate Cliff Holliday's 100th Birthday at the Ken Nakaoka Commu-

nity Center on September 28th. Mayor Don Dear, Councilmembers Steve Bradford, Al DeFilipo and Jim Cragin, City Treasurer Larry Ybarra and City Clerk May Doi joined together to present Cliff with a Resolution celebrating his 100 years. Torrance Councilman George Nakano presented Cliff with a Resolution from the City of Torrance. Many other groups awarded Cliff for his many, many years of activism. Cliff has tirelessly worked for Neighborhood Watch, Universal Health Care and to save Social Security and Medicare from the Republicans who are out to destroy them, as he noted in his speech to the revellers.

The government of France, after commemorating the 80th anniversary of the Armistice that ended the first World War, announced that Cliff would be awarded the Legion d'Honneur for his



service in France during that war. Cliff served in the Canadian Army in the trenches of France. The 80th Anniversary of the Armistice ending the Great War was commemorated last November 11th by the President of France and by Queen Elizabeth II of the United Kingdom, along with a number of World War I veterans revisiting what remains of those trenches.

After the war, Cliff came to California where he helped pioneer movie lighting and adding sound to the "Talkies."

Cliff became politically active in the United States of America when Franklin Delano Roosevelt was President. Cliff was a strong supporter of President Roosevelt and of the Social Security system that was initiated by FDR.

Cliff has been a leader in the National Council of Senior Citizens (NCSC), the Congress of California Seniors and in the Gardena Valley Democratic Club for decades. He is one of the leaders in the fight against "privatizing" Social Security and Medicare. Last July at the FDR Memorial in Washington, DC, Cliff stood on the same NCSC podium as President Bill Clinton when he passed the Social Security Torch (literally) to our younger generation in the fight to preserve Social Security.

Cliff received a tremendous standing ovation for his long service to senior Americans and to our community.

CENSURE THE PRESIDENT AND MOVE ON!

Everyone knows that President Clinton had a little affair—he admitted to it and apologized to his family long ago. There was nothing criminal about it.
